The formation of such—an Institute was one of the major recommendations of the Canada India Network Initiative 2010 on Cardiovascular Health. To recognise the launch of the Institute and celebrate the effort in achieving this milestone, CINS is hosting a dinner on Feb 15, 2013 at the Royal Palace Banquet Hall in Surrey.

Fraser Health serves one of the largest populations with heritage in South Asia. The Institute will act as a catalyst for cooperation, collaboration and coordination between Fraser Health programs to better understand the specific health needs of the population, support development of evidence based programs and lower the chronic disease burden of individuals, families, communities and the health system. In addition the Institute will support academic, research and learning initiatives to better understand the reasons for higher prevalence of chronic diseases amongst South Asian population. As there is global interest in this issue, the Institute, with time, will collaborate with other stakeholders across Canada and globally-to achieve improved health outcomes for the South Asian population in Fraser Health and beyond.
